STATUTE NO. 45

THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER'S TITLE STATUTE 2014

The Synod of the Diocese of Waikato and Taranaki enacts as follows –

1 TITLE

This Statute is the Chief Administrative Officer's Title Statute 2014

2 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Statute is to standardise the title by which the chief administrative officer of the Diocese is described.

3 COMMENCEMENT

This Statute comes into force at the close of the Synod at which it is enacted.

4 CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER'S TITLE

(a) In every Statute of this Diocese hereafter enacted by the Synod, the chief administrative officer of the Diocese shall be referred to as the Registrar-Manager.

(b) Every reference to "Diocesan Secretary", "Diocesan Registrar", "Diocesan Manager", "Secretary", "Registrar", "Manager" or "Canon Registrar" in any existing Statute shall be read and construed as referring to the Registrar-Manager.

(c) Whenever an existing Statute is reprinted, following amendment or otherwise, the term "Registrar-Manager" shall replace "Diocesan Secretary", "Diocesan Registrar", "Diocesan Manager", "Secretary", "Registrar", "Manager" or "Canon Registrar" wherever any of those descriptions have been used in such Statute.
